Thank you Representative Dick Muri and his staff for hosting SSMCP at the 2017 Hill Day. Elected Officials learned more about the organization's legislative agenda. Senator Steve O'Ban and Senator Steve Conway sponsor the \$5M "ask" in state's capital budget toward resolution of the North Clear Zone. A dozen signatures in support of SSMCP's ask for a Transportation Corridor Plan for I-5 were obtained.

The strategy includes a phased approach to acquiring properties and providing assistance for business relocation to bring land uses in the NCZ into compliance with federal safety guidelines over the long term. It is focused on specific business and properties as well as safe military operations.


