



# 2026-2027 Work Plan

1. **Manage federal grant to implement Military Installation Resiliency Review (MIRR) recommendations:**
  - a. Implement Defense Community Transportation Corridor Study (Transportation Work Group) (SSMCP)
  - b. Engage / assist in developing a Defense Community Communications Interoperability Plan (JBLM)
  - c. Promote Energy Grid Resilience Project (JBLM)
2. **Implement relevant recommendations from statewide military/defense sector economic impact analysis**
  - a. Leverage economic impact study to conduct information, education, and awareness campaign (Business and Economic Development WG)
  - b. Promote and enhance the use of the Defense Community Compatibility Account such as clear zone encroachment
3. **Advocate / promote/ support military quality of life initiatives (Legislative Agenda)**
  - a. Explore opportunities to develop a military spouse workforce pipeline through community partnerships (Business and Economic Development WG)
  - b. Support the development of a regional comprehensive resource hub for military families (Healthcare and Social Services WG)
  - c. Support increased access to childcare for military families
  - d. Advocate for the expansion of educational support for military-connected children
  - e. Collaborate with partners to address food insecurity and behavioral health challenges affecting military families. (Social Services and Healthcare WG)
4. **Pursue funding for I-5 improvements and Nisqually Delta restoration (Legislative Agenda / Transportation WG)**
5. **Conduct JBLM Joint Land Use Study in 2027, which includes strategies to reduce suburban/military land use conflicts and strengthen compatible development policies (Reconstitute JLUS Task Force)**
6. **Inform / educate state legislators about SSMCP and advocacy in state-level activities (Legislative Agenda)**
  - a. Establish a unified statewide network of defense communities to strengthen coordination and alignment of priorities.
7. **Engage when appropriate with the Commercial Aviation Work Group (SSMCP staff)**
